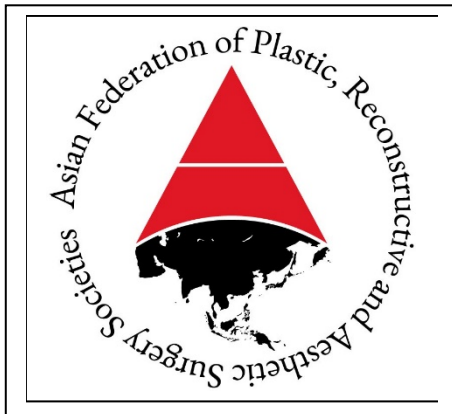


The 4th year of APRAS

APRAS member section: MSPRS

Malaysian Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (MSPRS)

MSPRS was formed on March 23rd, 2009 as a professional body representing plastic surgeons in Malaysia. Membership is open to all qualified Malaysian plastic surgeons. To date we have **110 members** who are attached to the government, university and private hospital facilities throughout West and East Malaysia. This makes MSPRS the largest representation of plastic surgeons in Malaysia. 66% of plastic surgeons registered under the National Specialist Register (NSR) are MSPRS members. The table below highlights the distribution of plastic surgeons in the country according to place of work.

MSPRS members contribute to the training of plastic surgeons under both university and government hospital training facilities. MSPRS also works closely with the Ministry of Health and sit on several regulatory bodies such as the Aesthetic Medical Practice (AMP) committee and Letter of Credentialing and Privileging (LCP) committee among others.

MSPRS sponsors travel grants for residents and surgeons to encourage oral presentations in international scientific meetings. The society also organises preparatory courses for medical officers sitting for the MedEx plastic surgery examination (entry examination for Master of Surgery (Plastic Surgery) programme).

MSPRS Meeting

MSPRS organised its 16th Annual General Meeting in 2025. This is accompanied by an annual scientific meeting, the MSPRS Meeting. In recent years, MSPRS Meetings have become an international event with multiple international and local faculties sharing their knowledge and expertise in the areas of reconstructive and cosmetic surgery. This event is now conducted with the support of the Malaysian Conference and Exhibition Bureau (MyCEB), helping us bring together over 50 experts from both the international and local foray. In addition to this, MSPRS organised the inaugural Malaysian Scar Symposium (MyScar) in 2025 as well as an APRAS meeting. We were very honoured to have had with us a representative from every APRAS member country participating as faculty at our MSPRS Meeting 2025.

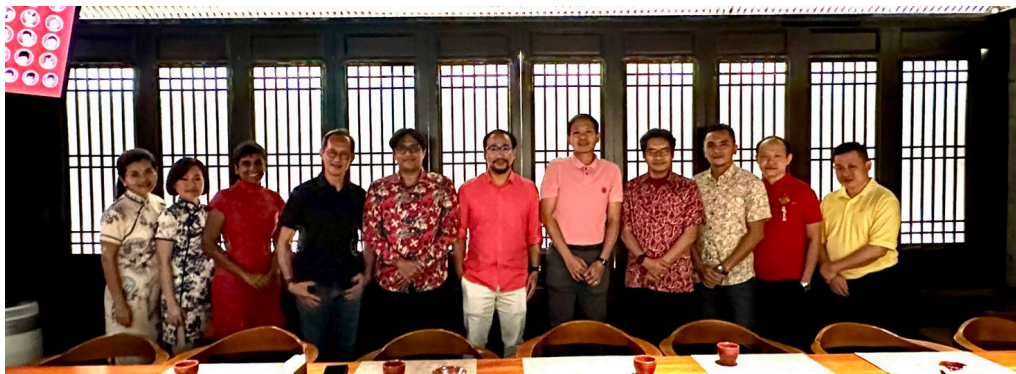
